I write regarding Issa Amro of Hebron. He is on trial in Israeli military court for 18 charges, almost all relating to his political activity and nonviolent activism, some dating back to 2010. Amnesty say the charges "do not stand up to scrutiny"; he faces a likely prison sentence. This is extreme and unfair and to me it looks like he is on trial just because of his role in Youth Against Settlements. I think Issa

actually has a role to play in bringing peace to the Middle East. Making an example of Issa in the way the military court intends will only serve to reinforce the impression that peaceful opposition is pointless; it will drive youngsters into more extreme acts, possibly of violence. And that is something that I imagine both you and I would consider to be disastrous. Issa lives with danger; just after Xmas his home was attacked by settlers. Please consider releasing Issa from the charges against him. I think, long-term, history will judge you have done the right thing.
